RESOLUTION NO. 21-2017-8
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A \$.25 INCREASE IN THE PUBLIC, EDUCATION,
AND GOVERNMENT FEE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2017, the LaPrairie City Council held a public hearing regarding a proposed \$.25 increase in the Public, Education, and Government (PEG) fee that is charged by cable companies and passed onto Itasca Community Television, Inc. and


WHEREAS, the current charge is \$1.00 per month per subscriber, and the proposed increase of \$.25 would be an increase of \$3.00 a year per subscriber, and

WHEREAS, the PEG was last increased in 2012 and since that time, the cost of living has increased by 6%, and


WHEREAS, this increase is also necessary to update transmission devices, support volunteer production equipment, and staff equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of LaPrairie, Itasca County, Minnesota, authorizes a \$.25 increase in the Public, Education, and Government fee effective January 1, 2018.
